Description

Judging Criteria

- Innovation
- Design (Compactness and the efficiency of work done)
- Efficiency (Performance of said task)
- Relevance with practical need.

Note :

- Partial outputs are considered.
- All selected participants will receive participation certificate.
- Participants should bring all their requirements to execute their project.
- The decision of the judges shall be treated as final and binding.
- The panel of judges consists of subject experts from our college.
- The organizers reserve the rights to change any or all of the above rules as they deem fit

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Each team can have maximum of 4 members.
- Team members must register together in one form.
- The competition is open only to under-graduate students.
- Members should have a valid student ID card of their college.

Round 1 :

- * The project for competition must be submitted in a soft copy either in doc or ppt format by 15th March.
- * The soft copy should contain a simple description about their project.
- * The candidates can take help of following points to describe their project in the soft copy.
 - Introduction
 - Working principle.
 - Its advantage and disadvantages
 - Future Work

Round 2 :

- *The Shortlisted candidates must exhibit their project on the day of Tech Udbhav 19
- *There will be on-spot public polling on a digital medium.
- *Students must be prepared to answer judges' questions about the content and development of their projects.
- *Students must set up their project, remain with it throughout their judging period, and remove it at the end of the day.
- *Participants must abide by all rules set by the organizing Team. Failure to do so may result in the participant's disqualification.
- * Teams will be given a space to set up their model/design at the venue.
